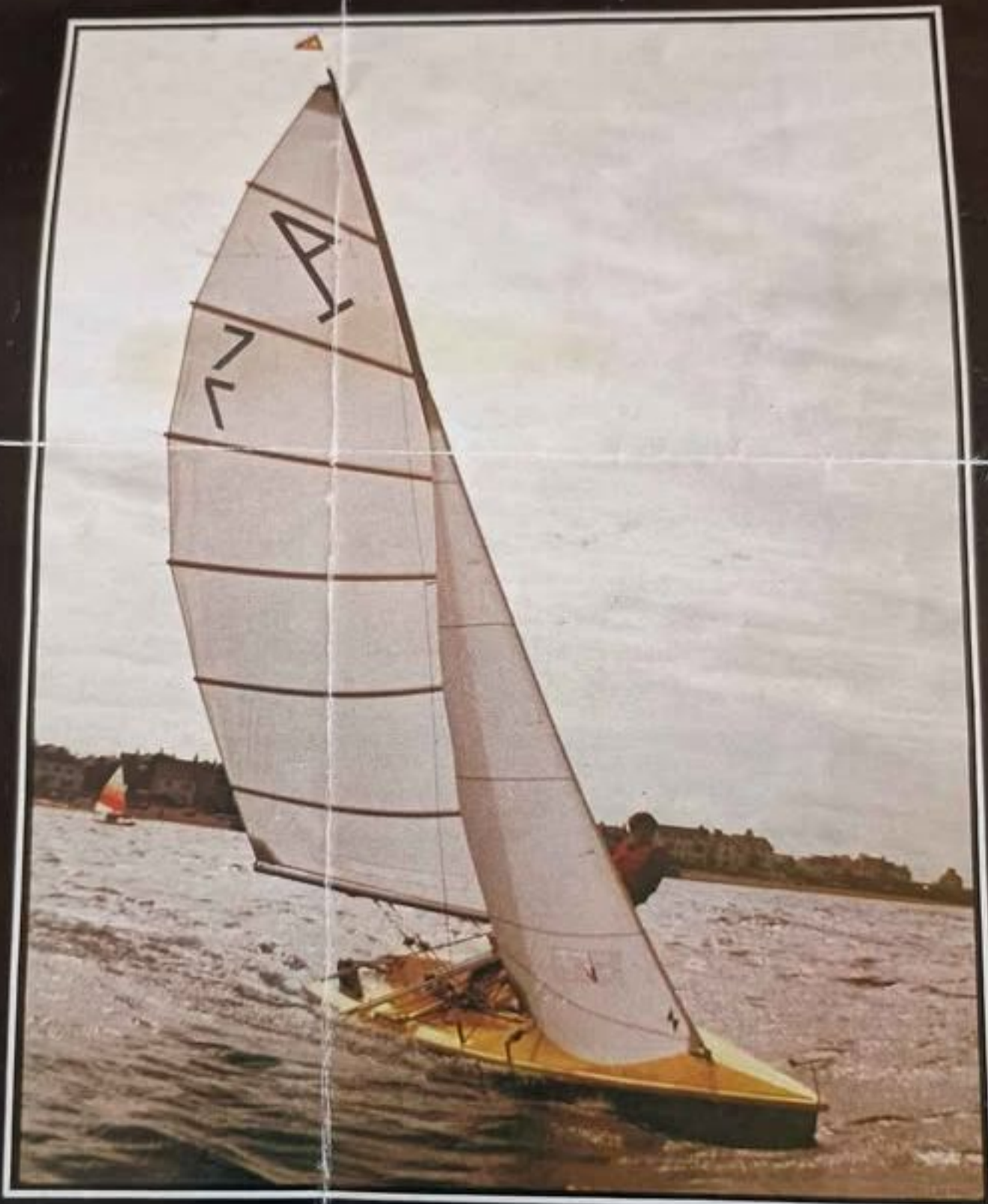


# Are you a Wizard sailor?

# About the Wizard

Wizards have magical powers and can work wonders which is why the name was chosen for what is probably the most exciting single handed boat developed for years. Single handed sailing is the thing to do—look at the truly deserved success of the "Laser"! But what else is there that is much faster, not weight critical and is a true "full time" single hander? **Only the Wizard.**

It has the performance of a "Fireball", is easy to sail for those with a little experience and uses the most modern "proved" materials with a design that equates with aircraft technology.

**To start with it's virtually four boats in one** use the small main (78 sq. ft.—optional) and **from your seat** unfurl your jib (another 30 sq. ft.)—you still have a perfectly balanced boat that will virtually "take off".

Set the racing main (100 sq. ft.) and you have full aircraft type power—**now** unfurl that jib and remember it's **self tacking** so you just "set it and forget it".

The boat is remarkably stable and dry—it's so easy to right that it often comes up sailing (nothing to drain).

## Who can sail a Wizard?

The average helmsman with very little practice and a good one with ease. You don't have to be young, or a 'trapeze artist'—the low Dinghy Yardstick of 104 is for average helmsmen.
